



Hello Camp Serenbe Parents!

We are looking forward to having your child join us for camp. Below is a list of everything your child needs for camp each day and all additional details regarding drop off, emergency contact information, etc. Please read and let us know if you have any questions.

Camp Checklist:

Campers should come EACH DAY with these items.

Please have everything in a labeled bag.

- Swimsuit
 - Towel
 - Sunscreen
 - Hat or visor (if they like to wear it)
 - Water bottle **with their name**
 - Change of clothes
 - Flip-flops or waterproof shoes to wear to and from the pool
- **some Enrichment Program campers do not need a swim suit, towel or flip-flops***

Lunch: Two Options

- A packed lunch (please make the lunch picnic appropriate: sandwiches, finger foods, etc.)
Lunches will be stored in a cool room but not refrigerated. Please include an icepack if desired.
- Order Lunch (complete order form **three weeks prior** to your camp session start date)

Additional Items:

- Closed toe shoes for the ropes course and hike (green, orange, and yellow groups)
- Horseback riding campers will need boots and long pants
- Any flotation device that your child needs to be in the pool
- Bug spray

Drop off and Pick up Information

- Please send your child to camp in clothes that can get **dirty**. Please apply sunscreen in the morning before they arrive to camp. We will re-apply half way through the day – **with sunscreen provided in their bag**.
- Drop off is at 9:00 am and pick up is at 3:00 pm at **the Pavilion** on the Inn grounds. **Please do not arrive before 9:00 am**.
- If you registered for aftercare, pick up is at 5:00 at the Pavilion.
- Aftercare is available on a day to day basis Monday-Thursday until 5:00 pm. Please email our director kara@campserenbe.com no later than 5:00 pm on the evening prior to the day you need aftercare.
- If you did not register for aftercare and your child has not been picked up by 3:10, they will go to aftercare and you will be charged for the day.

Friday Carnival

- We will take group pictures on Friday morning before we begin our activities for the day. Please send your child to camp in their Camp Serenbe t-shirt. Please also send them with their swim suit on under their clothes only on Friday.
- At 2:30 pm, we will gather in the Pavilion and the campers will perform their camp songs. **Parents are encouraged to come at this time to see the performance.**
- Feel free to bring a blanket or chair to sit on during the performance.
- There will be King of Pops popsicles available for everyone at the conclusion of the performance. If you would like a popsicle for yourself or a sibling who did not attend camp please bring cash. Additional popsicles will be \$3 each.

Pictures

- We take lots of pictures each day so you can see all of the fun at camp!
- We have a Camp Serenbe page on Facebook and Instagram so please become a fan and you can see pictures that will be uploaded each week.
- We will also post pictures to the CampInTouch account. Pictures will be posted at the end of the week and an email will be sent with information on how to view pictures.
- Parents are always given the option of not having pictures of their child posted if they prefer. Please let us know if you do not want pictures posted.

Inn Guests

- If you are staying at The Inn please pack plenty of clothes for your campers. They have a lot of fun all day and tend to wear it home on their clothes. It is not unusual to go through a change or two each day.

- If your child is causing continuous problems in their group, they will be asked to sit out. If the problem persists, the child will be sent home.

Additional Guidelines

- No cell phones or electronic games at camp. Personal cameras are allowed.
- Please let your child enjoy the camp experience on their own. If you are staying on the Inn grounds or in the community for the day, please take this time to enjoy your own adventure. We know it can be tempting to see the fun your child is having at camp and you will experience this on Friday during the performance and through all the pictures we take!
- We do spend time in the woods, so please check for ticks each day.
